The health sector is central to effective climate action at local and sub-national levels. Health systems and populations are increasingly impacted by climaterelated hazards, making effective local adaptation, thorough risk assessments and strategic communication crucial for minimizing health risks and building resilience.

This second deep dive of the EHP Partnership for Health Sector Climate Action explores how countries are tackling the challenges of local adaption to the impacts of climate change. Recognizing that countries may experience different impacts in different geographical areas, it is essential that the health sectors are informed and equipped to ensure that their input is taken into account in local and sub-national adaptation actions.

During a two-hour interactive session, participants will explore practical standalone case studies from various Partnership member countries, reflecting diverse local adaptation experiences. Key topics include:

- · Health impact assessment and local climate action plans as tools for integrating health considerations into climate adaptation;
- · Frameworks for climate risks assessment and strategies to support local adaptation in the health sector;
- · A Climate Resilience Check for Health tool that integrates international climate frameworks into local-level adaptation strategies and national policies;
- · Examples of healthcare facilities implementing resilience and adaptation strategies;
- · A communication initiative with stakeholder engagement at city level for public health services to integrate climate adaptation tools into decisionmaking.

This event will be particularly valuable for health and local government professionals engaged in climate action, as well as policymakers seeking effective strategies to strengthen national climate adaptation efforts.
