What is the gap?


- Standardize in a multi-stakeholder framework, including outcomes that matter to patients
- Implement in clincial practice
- Establish confidentiality/trust and convince populations that their data is safeguarded; communicate the benefits of data collection


- Create multi-stakeholder **consensus** on PROs and core outcome sets that can be measured in clinical practice across several countries;
- Equip patients with **practical tools** to measure their outcomes in a standardized manner and improve clinical care both at a patient and population level;
- Create an ethical framework around data **governance** to establish trust and enable data analysis to advance health science and policy.


