- Provides templates for consent, reports, etc.
- Member of the Pan-European H2O Observatory
- Members could be institutions and individuals

GÖG provides a wide range of anonymized/ aggregated data (aggregated tables, SQL databases, etc.) to all stakeholders (private and public) in a ethically and legally appropriate manner and after all necessary approvals

## KEY LOCAL CONSIDERATIONS



The national H2O association advises and provides support to the partner organisations cooperating on the creation of the Austrian Data Platform.

H2O Austria will encourage the establishment of a national H2Oecosystem, and it shall additionally represent the interests of its members in the Pan-European H2O Observatory.

H2O Austria supports and facilitates the collection of health outcomes in Austria, with a special focus on patients' perspectives by providing education material, workshops, expertise for implementation of core outcome sets, analytic support, and expertise for publications.

The association will promote fair principles for the access to health outcomes data in Austria. It consolidates the interests of different stakeholder groups, including public and private sectors, regulators and authorities, and patients and citizens.

It will furthermore provide advice regarding sustainability of health outcomes data collection in a non-for-profit manner, including access to the H2O data platform.
